Main operating account:

Balance is \$3600.93. Since our last meeting, we have moved \$10,000 to the playground account. \$280 was collected towards staff appreciation and we spent \$766.77 on lunch and snacks for the staff on different days that week. Along with the \$500 motioned/budgeted and \$280 collected, we were able to fund this special event! We are also moving \$600 out that has gone to fund band clinicians, which was something we also budgeted and motioned at the beginning of the year. We do know there is a bit more money needing to be transferred for festival purchases and will have that exact amount for you all next meeting.

I did want to mention that sadly I will not be returning as treasurer next year. I will still try to help out whenever I can. I know a wonderful candidate will be voted in for next year! Thank you!
