
School population- 520 students

Highlights

- Grade 6 students currently being transported by a RETSD school bus will not be eligible for free busing in Grade 7. According to the Manitoba Education Public Schools Act Regulation (M.R. 259/2006) Grade 7 to Grade 12 students living within the city limits are not eligible for school bus transportation. Fee-for-Service may be available. If you are considering this option, please submit a Transportation Application Fee-For-Service 2023-24 form. Forms are available from the school office or on the Transportation icon located on divisional home page at www.retsd.mb.ca.
- Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the Transportation Department by June 30th of each school year. Applications received after June 30th will be reviewed on an individual basis.
- First WELLNESS Day for students on March 1st was a success. 100% of students who responded on the post surveys stated they enjoyed an afternoon of cross grade learning and down time. We may try again in May!
- We will be hosting our ERP EXPO celebration of learning on March 22nd (5:00-7:00 p.m.). It is a school wide event, and students will be demonstrating their learning not only to their own families, but to the whole ERP family. A detailed letter has been sent home.
- Spirit Week (March 20th to March 24th). Student leaders are looking at having another dance for grades 6-8 (with other options) plus an outdoor scavenger hunt and outdoor adventures for the grade 4-5 students. More information to follow.
- Grade 8 (some grade 7 students) Brandon Band trip a huge success.
- Badminton grades 6-8 has begun.
- Grade 5 students have been working with Artists in the Schools residency-(Leanne Kehler) on story telling through Music. They will be performing on May 18th at ERP.
- Grade 4 students will be singing in the Choir for the EC- EMU grades 2, 3 and 4 transition tour on May 1st at 10:00 a.m. Families- Parents welcome.
- Grade 6-8 Performing Arts concert on May 15th at CPET- More information to follow.

 - -thank you to everyone for all your fundraising, grant writing and to Lucia and Chris for everything they have done
 - -not 100% sure of the timeline of all our finances coming together as we are still waiting for Lottos to take their 1.5% from our raffle so we will need to leave some money in the playground account but we will be able to move the majority of the money to the trust fund so we can get to where we need to be

-we need to send a package to the school division to get the final approval and we need to show that we all approve of this playground and the transfer of the funds so we can pay for it

-at one of the previous meetings it was brought up that PAC could possibly transfer \$10,000 to the playground account as Lucia and Chris are not requesting any more money other than what has already been approved at the beginning of the year

For \$10,000 from the PAC account to be transferred to the playground account to go towards the playground.

MOTIONED CARRIED

-need to approve the quote of \$123,528.30 from Colcat Enterprise (a Henderson Playground Co)

-playground design has lots of slides, climbing and creates a continuous circuit; promotes lots of movement and activity; accessible steps to allow inclusive play

-Colcat owns their own equipment and has their own crew to do the work; nothing is contracted out; this allows for a better time frame because everything is co-ordinated in house; should be able to have it done by September as long as the paperwork all goes through in time

What will be on the ground: playground wood chips

Are grants covering the majority of the playground: Up until now approximately \$70,000 has been fundraised, the approval of the \$10,000 from PAC, \$40,000 from EC Daycare

 - -left to come out of the account is up to \$500 for staff appreciation, \$400 for grade 8 farewell and \$600 for band
- -motion was approved of \$10,000 to be transferred to the playground account
- -will leave just over \$2500 in the account
