Community Values in Public Education System

ThoughtExchange Report to Community

January 2022



In December 2021, the River East Transcona School Division (RETSD) board of trustees (BOT) created a ThoughtExchange to gather community input on the value of our public school system.

There were 1,017 participants in the ThoughtExchange, sharing 919 thoughts and 25,053 ratings. Most participants were parents/guardians of students in K–12.
