What time of day are the hockey classes?	Hockey classes begin before the regular school day. Drop off time at the arena will be approximately 8:05 – 8:10. On-ice time begins at 8:30 am. Students are on-ice for 50 minutes, once per cycle, for the equivalent of 1 school period, including time for changing, showering, and travel. Students will walk back together at approximately 9:40 am. Bag pick- up will be at 9:35 am at the rink or after school until 6 pm. Students will still have 3 PE classes per cycle in school.
