<b>BAND STUDENT Instrument Supplies and Rental:</b>
Parents/Guardians have three options for band instruments for their child:
1. ESMP charges <b>\$40.00</b> for an entire year of band instrument rental (three terms). This cost includes a band instrument and any reeds or oils needed for your child's instrument.
2. If you have access to one of the following instruments (flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, tenor saxophone, bari saxophone, trumpet, trombone, bass clarinet, french horn, euphonium, tuba), your child can use this instrument in band. Parents/guardians are responsible for any reeds or oils needed for their child's instrument.
3. If you prefer to rent an instrument from a music store rather than rent from the school, Quest Musique, Long & McQuade, and St. John's Music all offer rental programs. The average rental cost is approximately <b>\$150.00</b> . Parents/guardians are responsible for any reeds or oils needed for their child's instrument.
