

DEFINITIONS FOR WEAPONS POLICY

- (A) **WEAPON:** Anything used, designed to be used or intended for use in causing death or injury to any person or for the purpose of threatening or intimidating any person.
- (B) **POSSESSION OF A WEAPON FOR DANGEROUS PURPOSE:** Involves a person carrying or possessing a weapon, an imitation of a weapon, a prohibited device or any ammunition or prohibited ammunition for a purpose dangerous to the public peace or for the purpose of committing an offence.
- (C) **THREAT WITH A WEAPON:** When a person who has a weapon in his/her possession in any manner knowingly utters, conveys or causes any person to receive a threat to cause death or bodily harm to any person; to burn, destroy or damage real or personal property; or to kill, poison or injure an animal or bird that is the property of any person.
- (D) **ASSAULT WITH A WEAPON:** When a person who has a weapon in his/her possession applies or attempts to apply force intentionally to another person directly or indirectly without the consent of that other person or causes that other person to believe on reasonable grounds that he or she has present ability to effect this purpose.
