# COUNTDOWN TO KINDERGARTEN

Starting kindergarten is a major milestone in your child's educational journey. As you are preparing for the first day of school, know that your child's school and teacher are preparing to meet both you and your child.

In River East Transcona School Division, we strive to make our classrooms safe, caring places of learning, where students feel included, respected, secure, and valued.

Your child will grow as a learner through activities that encourage inquiry, discovery, imagination, creativity, and problem-solving.

Our staff recognizes that you are your child's first teacher, and we look forward to collaborating with you to make kindergarten both a time for learning and a time for joy.

#### **Registering for Kindergarten**

Registration begins on Monday, March 1, 2023.

At your appointment, please provide proof of age documentation for your child (e.g., birth certificate, baptismal certificate, passport, Manitoba Health Card, INAC status card, birth registration signed by the director of Vital Statistics). You will also be asked for two pieces of identification for proof of residency (e.g., driver's licence, Manitoba Health Card, tenancy agreement, offer to purchase documents, utility bill).
