Dear Parents/Guardians of Students moving to Grade 6 in 2019-2020 at Robert Andrews School,

We, the staff members of Robert Andrews School, are very excited about the next school year – the first year for your child in a Middle Years school.

To ease the transition, we have held an Open House, hosted student tours, and have attended transition meetings with staff from the sending Early Years schools.

Large Instrument Rental Fees and Percussionist Fees (as applicable) payable to "Robert Andrews School" by November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

STUDENT FEES: \$65.00 - Due on the first day of school payable to: "Robert Andrews School"

Fees in this area will be used to cover the cost of basic consumables and supplementary materials used by students throughout the year in various subject areas. It will also be used for many, if not all, of the following: to support special activities, quest speakers, or artists; to enrich programming; lock and locker use, student leadership activities, yearbook, seed book, portfolio and computer printing. In cases where students are completing more advanced or complicated projects an additional fee may need to be assessed.
