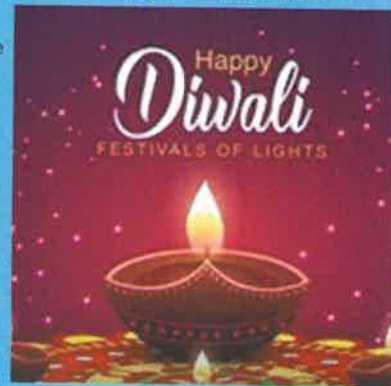

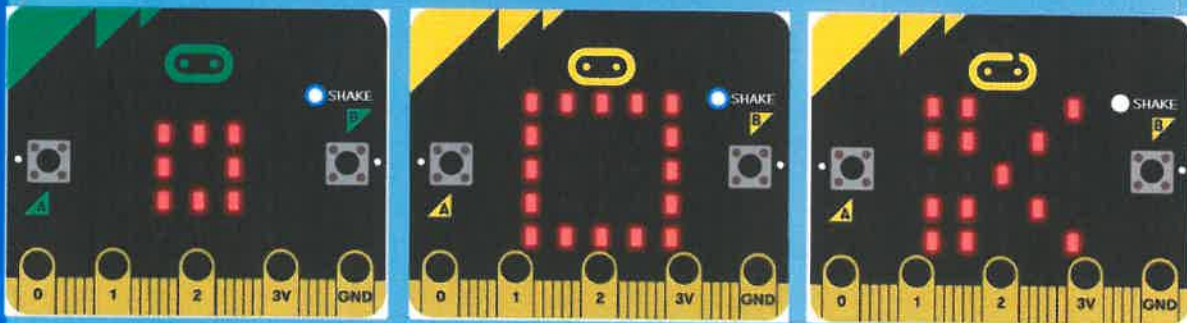
Tuesday, October 25th

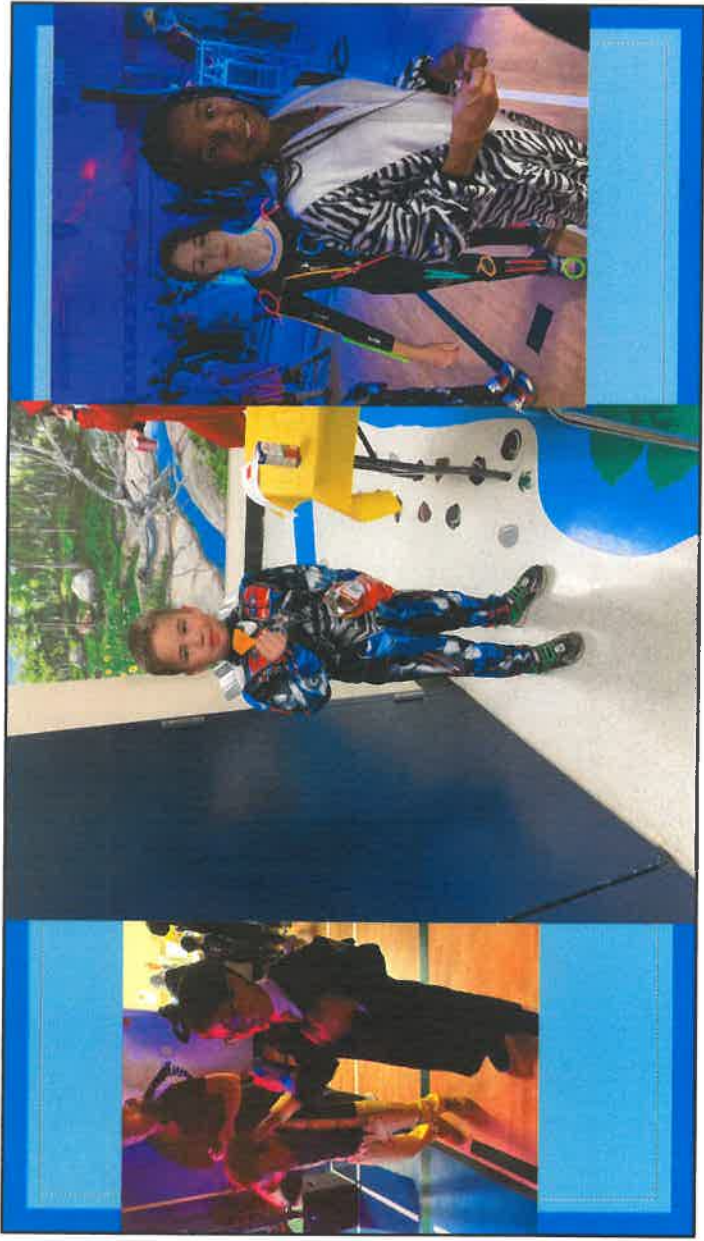

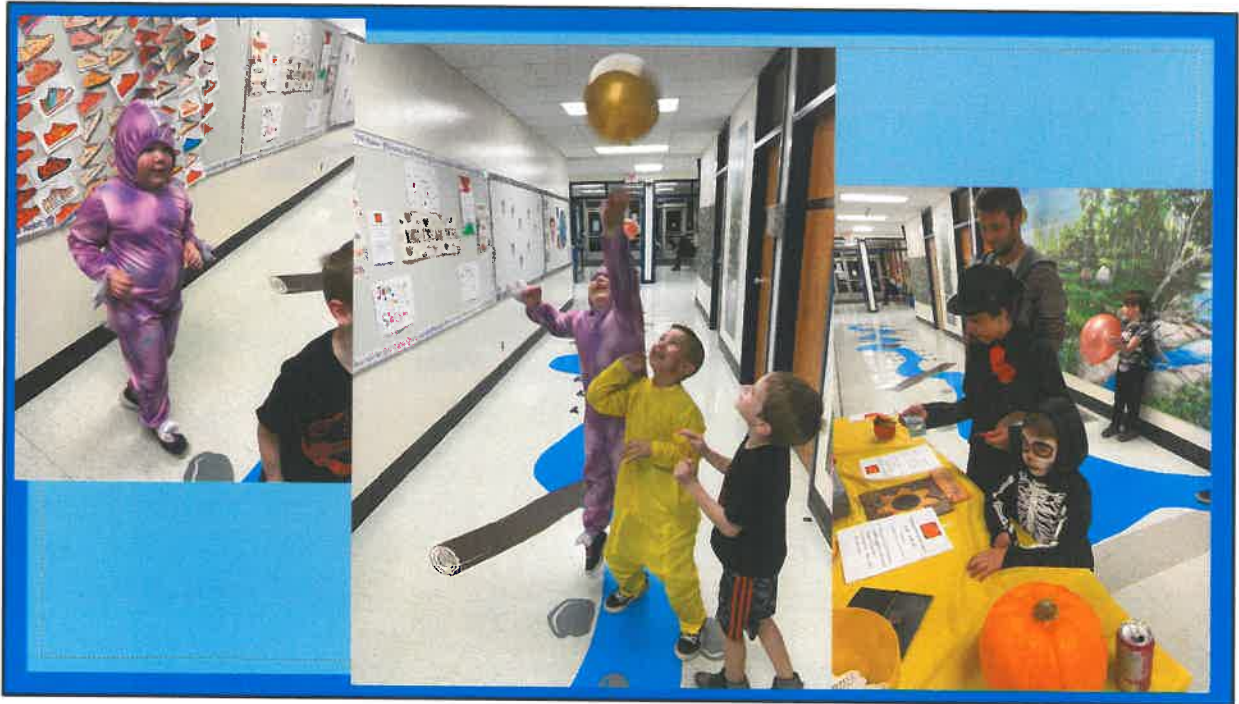
On Thursday, October 26th students had an active day including the following events:

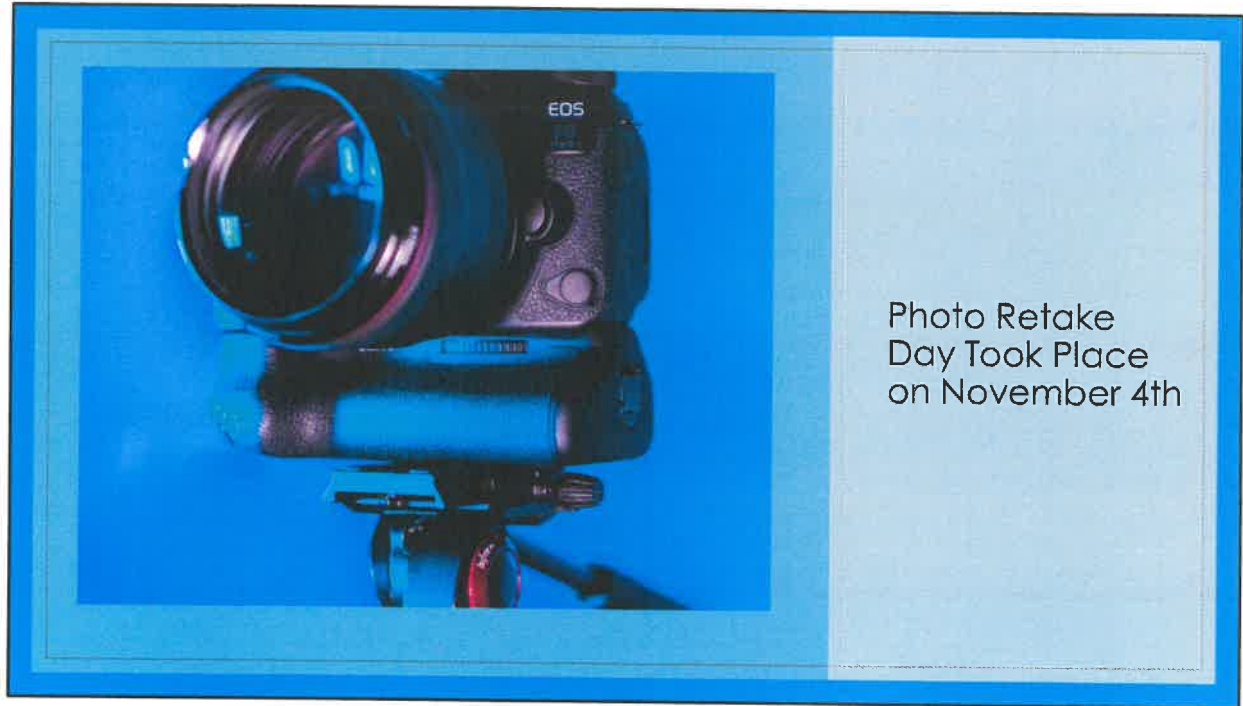
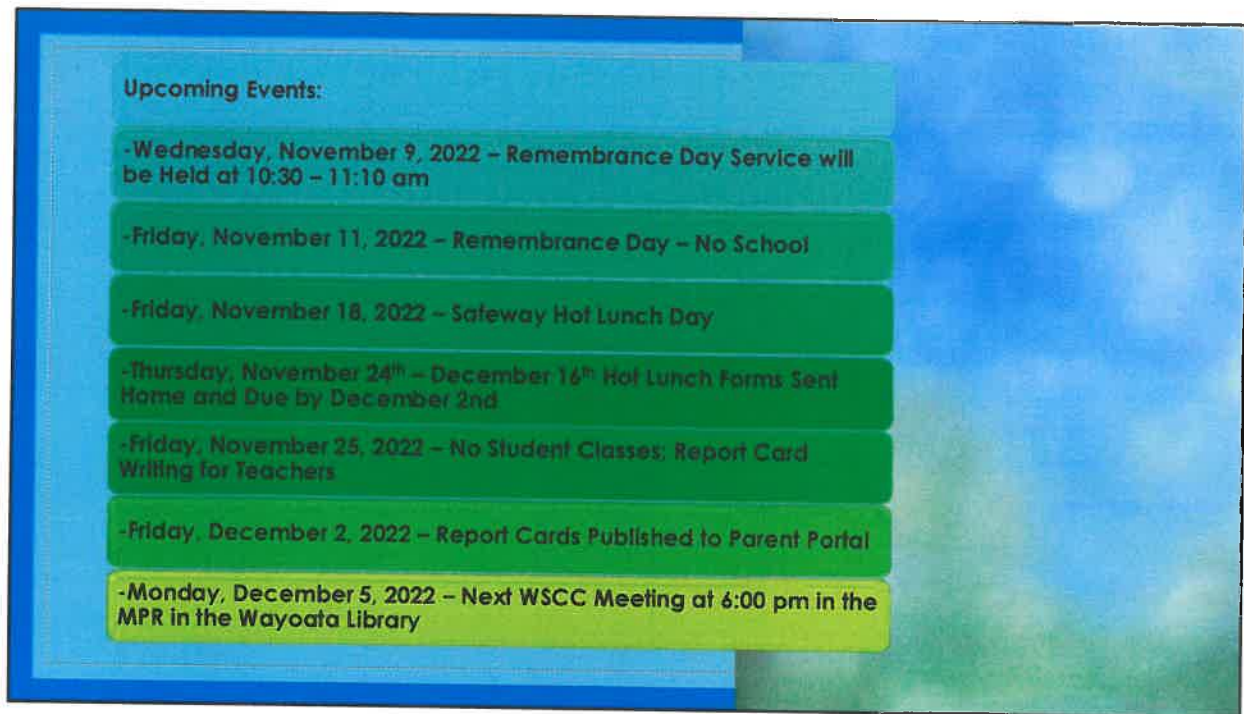


Photo Retake Day took place on November 4th, 2022 so students/parents can expect their photo proofs in the near future.
